Dear Families of Ross Students,

It is amazing that we are now in the 2nd quarter, fast approaching the end of the first semester for this school year. Time is flying by. As this school year has had many successes, we are still dealing with the challenge of attendance. Our district attendance policy allows students to be called off by the parent/guardian as an excused absence five times for the entire school year. After 5 excused absences, students will need a doctor's note for the absence to have it excused. Regular attendance improves your child's school success and experience. If your child is absent, please encourage them to review their Google Classroom for each class to stay as caught up as possible. It is also critical that you and your child remain in communication with your child's teachers to ensure they are being successful in the classroom.

Upon returning from our Thanksgiving Break, Ross students who need to complete retakes for competency scores and graduation seals will have the opportunity during the Ohio State Testing window, November 28th - December 15th. Those students testing need to give their best effort as these tests do impact their graduation pathway.

The first semester will end on December 20th. Beginning on December 18th, semester exams will be scheduled for each class. A testing schedule is included in this newsletter and will be shared out via Final Forms and through our school announcements.

This quarter we have several events scheduled for the Fremont community to participate. Fremont Ross High School will have our annual Veterans' Day celebration on November 9th. We will host the American Red Cross Bloodmobile on that same day. Please consider donating blood to help others. We also now have tickets on sale for our school play, **High School Musical**, the weekend of November 17-19th. December has scheduled concerts and parades that include many of our students. ACE Mentoring Program (Assisting Children to Excel)

ACE Mentoring at Ross High School is off to a positive start for the school year. Many relationships are being established along with exceptional mentoring happening.

ACE is a career based mentoring program that is designed to help students establish career goals, plan for their future, and succeed in school. Mentoring is held in person during a study hall, or non-core classes, and students have an opportunity to talk about the social pressures and issues that they may be experiencing. Students are encouraged to succeed in school and have good attendance.

Throughout the school year, mentors and mentees have talking points they talk about during the mentoring sessions. Topics are organizational skills, skills for smart studying, graduation, career and what their future brings. Each mentoring session always encourages academic success.

We are currently serving 9th-12th grade students at Ross High School and 6th-8th grade students at Fremont Middle School. Any Fremont City School student is eligible to participate, but students are required to complete an application and parent permission is necessary.

Per FCS board policy JN, a letter was sent in October to parents/guardians of students with outstanding fees and fines. A payment schedule may be arranged with the Ross finance office with full payment to be received by June 14. Ingredients:

- 1 teaspoon olive oil
- ¼ Cup chopped onion
- 1 clove of garlic
- ½ pound italian sausage
- 16oz fat free low sodium chicken broth
- 1 can crushed tomatoes
- 1 teaspoon basil
- 1 teaspoon italian seasoning

- Pinch of black pepper
- 6oz cheese tortellini
- 1.5 oz fat free cream cheese
- 1 cup torn fresh spinach



Directions:

1. Heat olive oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add onions and cook for a few minutes till they are soft.
2. Add in garlic and sausage. Cook till sausage is no longer pink.
3. Add in the rest of the ingredients and cook for 15 minutes. Stir occasionally.

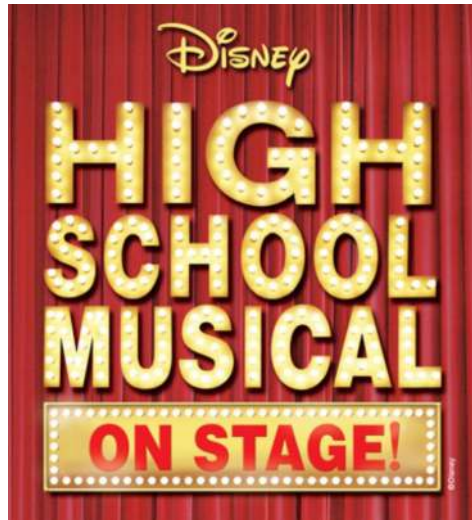
- Attendance Matters, All Day, Every Day -Remember to call the attendance office when your child is absent-419-334-2742
