Nurse's Corner

With cold, flu and stomach bug season in full swing, we ask that students experiencing the following symptoms be kept home until their symptoms are resolved for at least 24 hours to reduce the spread of infection:

- Fever (100.5 or above)
- Vomiting (from illness)
- Diarrhea
- Red painful eyes (with drainage or crusting)
- Unusual rash
- Difficulty breathing or severe cough
- Any symptoms that that require more care than what can be provided in school

If your child experiences one of these symptoms above while at school, they will be sent home (excused). When students come to the health office and <u>DO NOT</u> have the symptoms listed above and have minor complaints, we often try to encourage them to "stick it out." Sometimes, if your student makes multiple visits or has unusual complaints, we will call, text, or email you as a courtesy so

that you can help us decide the next best course of action. Parents are welcome to pick up their children for minor illness/complaints however these absences may not be excused by the nurse. If your child has a chronic condition that they are missing school for frequently, let's work together to come up with a plan! I am always happy to help.









PTO meets the second Tuesday of each month at 5:30pm in the Croghan Cafeteria. New families are always welcome!


Please remember to put your child's name in their coat and lunch bag so that the item can be returned to your child if it is misplaced.
